

# Making Audio and Video Recordings

## EASIEST METHODS ON A MAC

### Narrated Slideshow – Keynote, Quicktime

- Open **Keynote**
- Play** menu > Record Slideshow
- Check the microphone level (green bar in the bottom left)
- Click the record button
- Click the record button again
- Press **esc** on the keyboard
- File** menu > **Export to** > **Quicktime**

### Screen Recording – Quicktime

- Open **Quicktime Player**
- File** menu > **New screen recording**
- Choose microphone input (dropdown menu to the right of record button)
- Click the record button
- Choose to record the entire screen or a segment
- Click the record button in the menu bar (top of screen)
- Save the file

### Audio Recording – Quicktime

- Open **Quicktime Player**
- File** menu > **New audio recording**
- Choose microphone input (dropdown right of record button)
- Click the record button
- Click the record button again
- File** menu > **Save**

### Sharing with Others – YouTube

- Go to **YouTube**
- Log in with your UCSC credentials (if you aren't logged in already)
- Click **Upload** (top right)
- Choose the file
- Enter title, description, tags, etc.
- Set access to:
  - Public** - anyone in the world can see the video, and the video will appear in search results
  - Unlisted** - anyone in the world can see the video, but it will not appear in search results
  - Private** - only those you share the video with can see it
    - Share with individuals by listing their emails
    - Share anyone in the USCS domain by selecting "UCSC" in the drop-down
    - Share with a group by creating and then selecting a circle in Google+
- Click **Publish**
